



North Village Church Externship: A one-year training designed to develop leaders how to engage gospel centered relationships and multiply their efforts.

How does this happen?

The individual will work part-time with North Village Church as well as part-time with a local business. We will help you identify those opportunities, but it will be your responsibility to find employment.

There will be a 3-step process to this training that will include:

- Biblical understanding and application (3 hours a week)
 - Metanarrative of the gospel throughout scripture
 - Biblical anthropology
 - Walking in the Spirit
 - Mission of God
- Spiritual transformation (3 hours a week)
 - Participating in a neighborhood gathering weekly
 - 1-1 coaching with a pastor/ elder
- Mobilizing relationships (9 hours a week)
 - Identifying a list of 200 new contacts over the year (name / email)
 - Identify a list of 50 unchurched people over the next year (name / email)
 - Participate in a weekly hobby / interest with a group of new people
 - Personally see 10 new people connect to the vision of North Village Church through your efforts.
 - Personally see 2 people meet Jesus through your efforts

How do these relationships develop?

We follow a relational model in our philosophy; therefore, in every context we apply a model that is described in John 4 as Jesus interacts with the woman at the well:

- Enter: (John 4:6) Jesus enters into her world
- Engage: (John 4:7, 10, 13) Jesus engages her in conversation
- Express: (John 4:16) Jesus expresses and draws out spiritual truths
- Explore: (John 4:21-24) Jesus explores spiritual truths with her
- Enjoy: (John 4:34) After seeing her spiritual transformation Jesus tells the disciples that His joy is to do the will and work of the Father. Our greatest joy will be experienced when we are doing the will and work of our Heavenly Father.

We believe Jesus wired us to enjoy these types of relationships and will bless them as we step out in faith. It will be difficult at times, but when we look throughout scripture we see this modeled over and over.

Financial Responsibility?

As a new church plant we are going to need you to participate with us financially and raise a majority of your income. We will help with that process and provide you the needed resources, but the support raising will ultimately be your responsibility.

Salary: \$10 / hr @ 15 hrs a week:	\$7,800
Administrative needs: Books, materials, retreats, etc.:	\$600
Ministry Allowance: Coffees, cokes, lunch, etc.:	\$400
Total Cost:	\$8,800

North Village Church will absorb \$1,800 of it and will put you responsible to raise \$7,000 for the year as well as working a part-time job.
